As of July 1, 2022, the State of Indiana now requires home-based food vendors to [obtain a food handler certificate](#)\*. Ivy Tech offers ServSafe™ Food Handler training to meet this requirement. If you make food in your home and sell it at street fairs, farmers markets, and other places in the State of Indiana†, you must have food handler training.
