

Get Food Handler Training at Ivy Tech

As of July 1, 2022, the State of Indiana now requires home-based food vendors to <u>obtain a food handler certificate</u>*. Ivy Tech offers ServSafe[™] Food Handler training to meet this requirement. If you make food in your home and sell it at street fairs, farmers markets, and other places in the State of Indiana[†], you must have food handler training.
